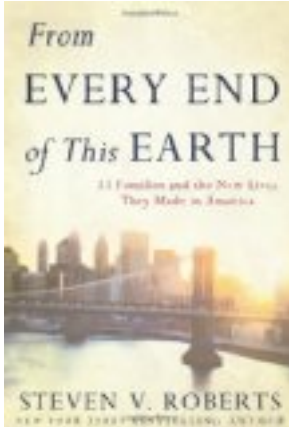


From Every End of This Earth: 13 Families and the New Lives They Made in America
