

NEW AMERICANS IN ALABAMA

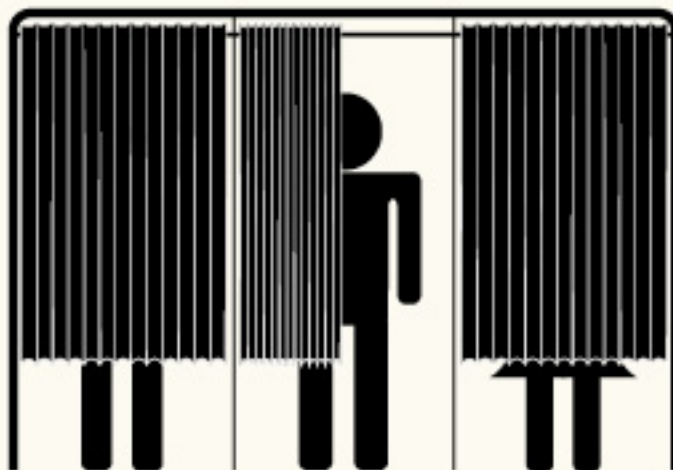


3.5% of Alabamans are foreign born.

5% of Alabamans are Latino or Asian.

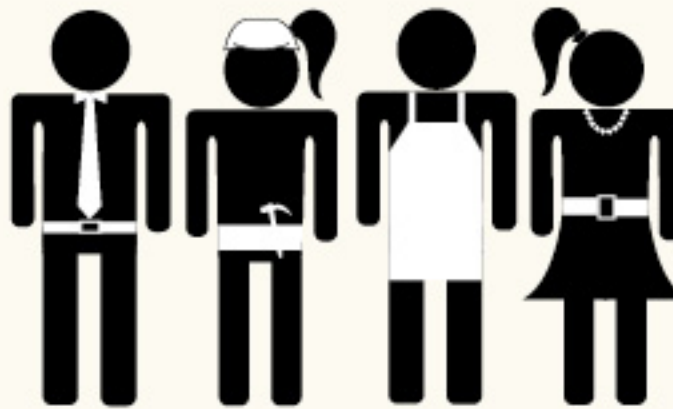
28.5% of immigrants in the state are eligible to vote.

.8% of registered voters are New Americans.



Alabama has 6,364 foreign students who contribute **\$122.9 million** to the state economy.

44.3% of foreign-born adults have a bachelor's degree or higher.



Asian-owned businesses in Alabama have sales and receipts of **\$2.6 billion**.

Latino-owned businesses in Alabama have sales and receipts of **\$1 billion**.

Immigrants are **4.9%** of the state's workforce. **4.2%** of the workforce is unauthorized.

The purchasing power of Alabama's Latino population and Asian population, respectively, is **\$3.7 billion** and **\$2 billion**.



84.6% of Alabama's children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens.

80.6% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient.

DID YOU KNOW? Alabama would lose **\$2.6 billion** in economic activity if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.
