

NEW AMERICANS IN COLORADO

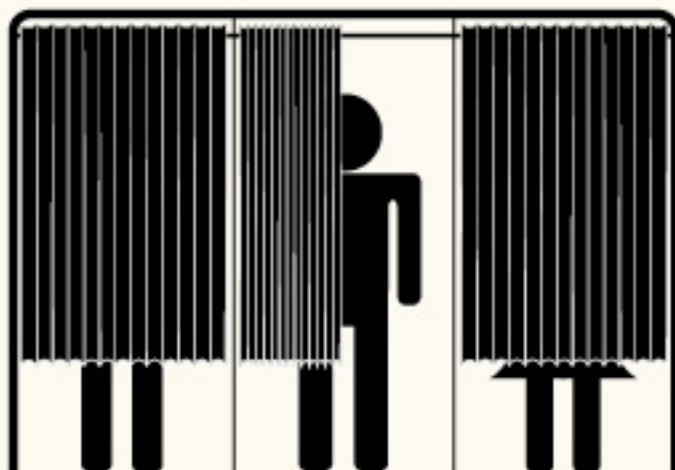


9.8% of Coloradans are foreign born.

23.4% of Coloradans are Latino or Asian.

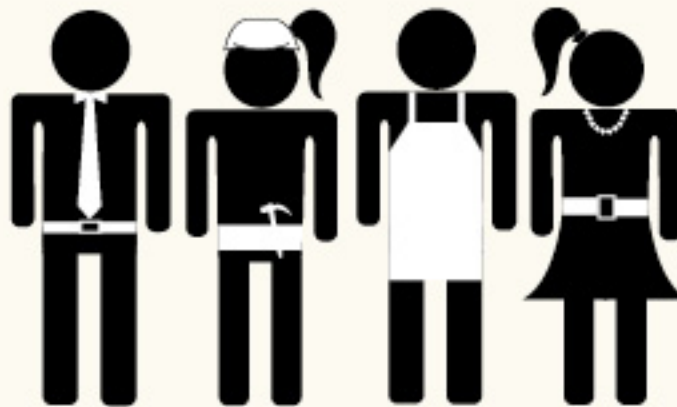
35.7% of immigrants in the state are eligible to vote.

5.9% of registered voters are New Americans.



Colorado has 6,980 foreign students who contribute **\$202.1 million** to the state economy.

The number of immigrants with a college degree increased **45.8%** over the last decade.

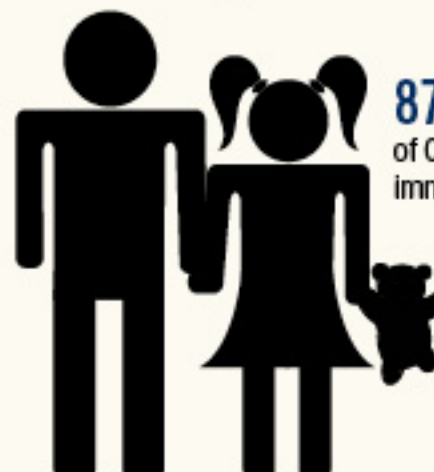


Asian-owned businesses in Colorado have sales and receipts of **\$3.4 billion**.

Latino-owned businesses in Colorado have sales and receipts of **\$6.6 billion**.

Immigrants are **11.7%** of the state's workforce. **4.6%** of the workforce is unauthorized.

The purchasing power of Colorado's Latino population and Asian population, respectively, is **\$21.9 billion** and **\$5 billion**.



87% of Colorado's children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens.

78.8% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient.

DID YOU KNOW? Colorado would lose **\$8 billion** in economic activity if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.
