

New Americans in Colorado



9.7% of Coloradans are foreign born

23.7% are Latino or Asian



35.9% of immigrants in the state are naturalized U.S. citizens

5.9% of registered voters are New Americans



87% of children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens

78.8% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient



81.8% of naturalized citizens have a high school diploma or higher

8,445 foreign students contribute **\$253.3 M** to the state's economy



Make up **11.4%** of the workforce.

4.6% of the workforce is unauthorized.



DID YOU KNOW?

Colorado would lose **\$8 billion** in economic activity and about **39,738 jobs** if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.

Latino-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$6.6 billion** and employed **37,629** people

Asian-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$3.4 billion** and employed **27,393** people

The purchasing power of Latinos is **\$21.8 billion**. Asian buying power totaled **\$6.6 billion**.
