

New Americans in Hawaii



17.9% of Hawaiians are foreign born
47.3% are Latino or Asian



55.9% of immigrants in the state are naturalized U.S. citizens
14.4% of registered voters are New Americans



88.0% of children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens
86.0% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient



82.6% of naturalized citizens have a high school diploma or higher
4,446 foreign students contribute **\$107.2M** to the state's economy



Make up **21.3%** of the workforce.
4.6% of the workforce is unauthorized.



DID YOU KNOW?

Hawaii would lose **\$2 billion** in economic activity and about **8,460 jobs** if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.

Latino-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$671.7 million** and employed **3,977** people

Asian-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$18.2 billion** and employed **111,924** people

The purchasing power of Latinos is **\$3.6 billion**. Asian buying power totaled **\$27.4 billion**.
