

NEW AMERICANS IN IOWA

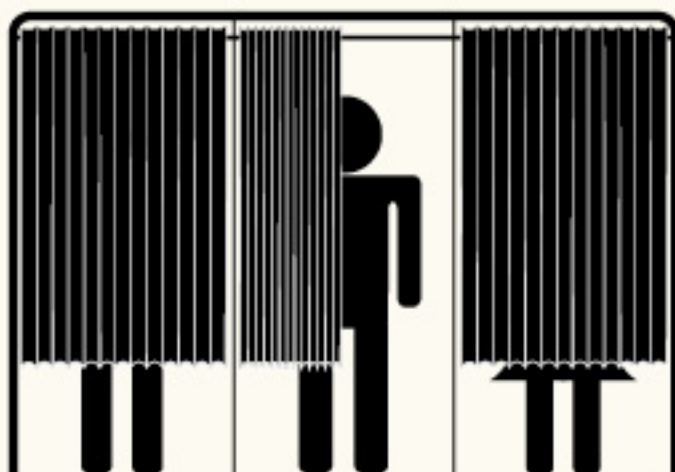


4.6% of Iowans are foreign born.

6.7% of Iowans are Latino or Asian.

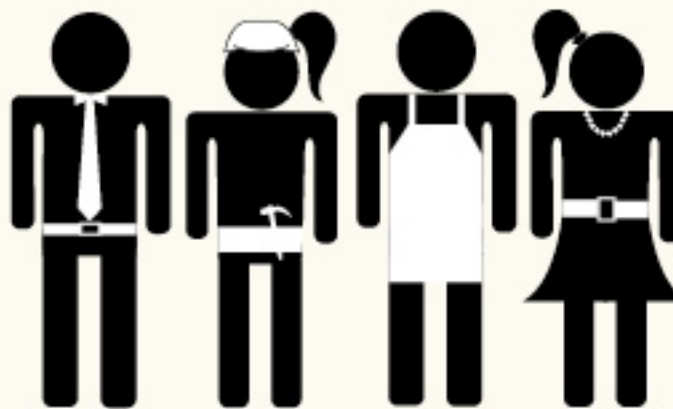
37.1% of immigrants in the state are eligible to vote.

2.6% of registered voters are New Americans.



Iowa has 9,647 foreign students who contribute **\$245.4 million** to the state economy.

30.7% of foreign-born adults have a bachelor's degree or higher.

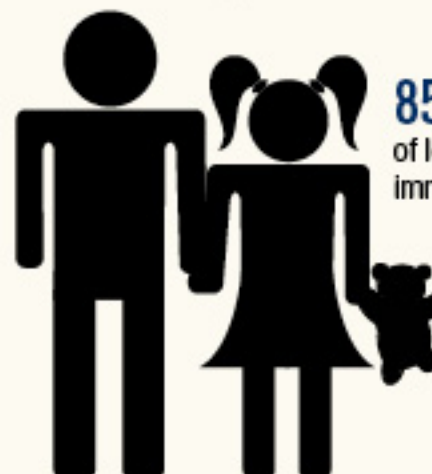
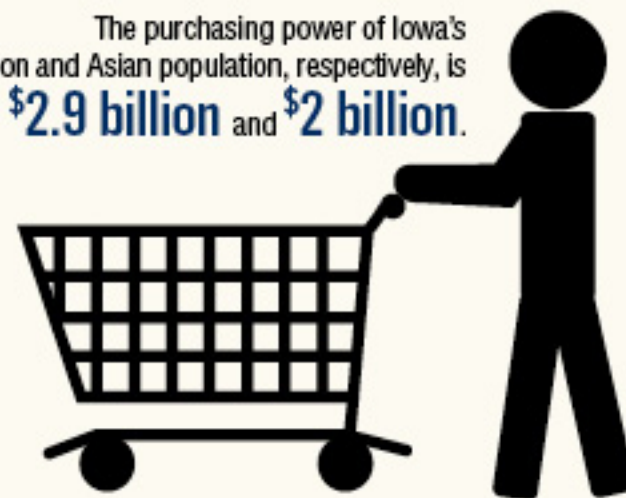


Asian-owned businesses in Iowa have sales and receipts of **\$782.6 million**.

Latino-owned businesses in Iowa have sales and receipts of **\$455.7 million**.

Immigrants are **5.6%** of the state's workforce. **3.2%** of the workforce is unauthorized.

The purchasing power of Iowa's Latino population and Asian population, respectively, is **\$2.9 billion** and **\$2 billion**.



85.2% of Iowa's children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens.

87% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient.

DID YOU KNOW? Iowa would lose **\$1.4 billion** in economic activity if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.
