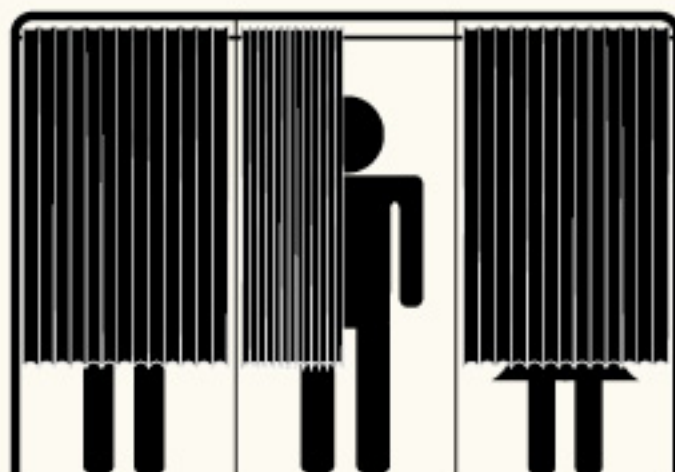


16.4% of Texans

are Latino or Asian.

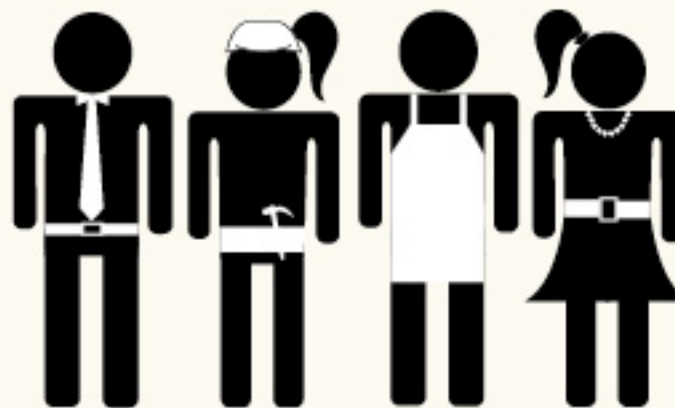
32%

have a bachelor's degree or higher.

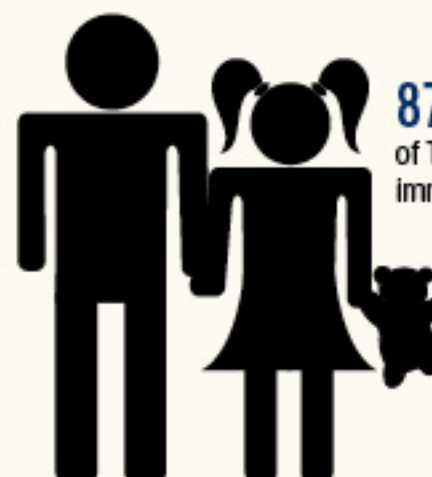
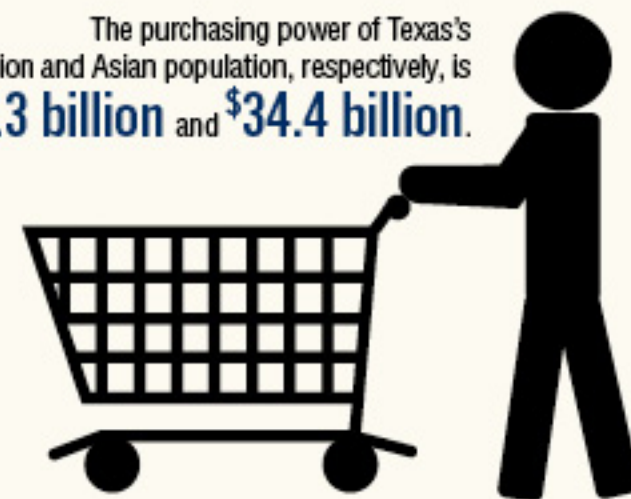


Asian-owned

Immigrants are **20.9%** of the state's workforce. **9%** of the workforce is unauthorized.

The purchasing power of Texas's
Latino population and Asian population, respectively, is
\$176.3 billion and **\$34.4 billion.**

75.2% of children
with immigrant parents are
English proficient.
